How are proposals submitted?

What will I need to submit a proposal?

You will need the following information to submit a proposal:

- Organizer Contact Info
- Session Title
- Session Level
- Session Description
- 3 Learning Objectives

What is the review process?

Proposals submitted on or before the deadline will be reviewed using the following criteria:

- Educational Value
- Timeliness of Topic
- Relevance
- Practical Application
- Overall Quality
- Appropriate Audience Type
- Speaker Qualifications and Expertise
- Newsworthiness and Novelty

When will I be notified if my proposal has been selected or not?

You will be notified of the status of your proposal, via e-mail, by March 31.

Can more than one speaker from the same company participate on a session?

No. All panel members must be from different organizations.

Who reviews the proposals?

All proposals are reviewed by the G2E Conference Advisory Board.

What does G2E provide financially for speakers?

While G2E does not provide speaker honoraria or reimburse for travel or housing, it does offer a complimentary all access conference pass (valued at \$1595) to confirmed speakers and moderators.

Will submissions received earlier be given higher consideration during the review process?

No. All submissions will be evaluated at the same time.
