



CONVENTION AND VISITORS AUTHORITY

ANIMALS

Permission for any domesticated animal (cats, dogs etc.) to appear in a show or booth must first be approved by Show Management then by the LVCVA Customer Account Manager.

The following criteria must be met before the animal is allowed on property:

1. The animal being shown must have something to do with the booth (i.e., a dog used in commercials, films, etc.)
2. A separate Certificate of Insurance in the amount of \$1 million combined single limit bodily injury and broad form property damage coverage, including broad form contractual liability, naming the Las Vegas Convention and Visitors Authority as **ADDITIONAL INSURED**.
3. Animals are not allowed to remain on property overnight.
4. A trainer must accompany animals at all times.
5. Other regulations may be deemed necessary depending on the type of animal.

Non-domesticated animals will be considered on an individual basis.

Seeing eye/assistance animals are always welcome.
